To the Santa Cruz Division:

Most of the business of the Senate Committee on Emeriti Relations was conducted through the members of the UCSC Emeritus Group. Following the precedent set by the initiator of the Group, the late Professor Albert Hofstadter, the emeriti have been meeting at luncheon about twice each term. One meeting was devoted to a discussion with Vice Chancellor Isebill Gruhn, one to an informal talk on the early days of the campus by Dr. Donald Clark, and one to a joint meeting with spouses. The last, to be held on June 7, will be devoted to a discussion of town-gown relations with Vice Chancellor Wendell Brase.

The Group which has nineteen dues-paying members, has now been assigned an office in the Classroom building and expects to conduct its future business from that location. The Chairman for next year will be Emeritus Professor Brewster Smith, and Dr. David Heron will continue as Alternate.
