Committee on Emeriti Relations Annual Report 1989-90

To The Santa Cruz Division:

As in recent years, the Senate Committee on Emeriti Relations functioned through the UCSC Emeritus group, which has been meeting about twice a term for lunch. During the year the group heard about the earthquake from Fred Hochstaedter, a graduate student in Earth Sciences; from Mary Holmes and from Ted Sarbin about their current activities and concerns; and from Gurden Mooser and Dean McHenry about their experiences in fund raising for the campus. A questionnaire circulated in June indicated general satisfaction with meetings that balance attention to current campus developments with sharing current concerns and activities of the members.

The chair and his alternate, Dr. David Heron, represent the UCSC Emeriti in the statewide Council of University of California Emeriti Associations (CUCEA), and will continue in that role in 1990-91. CUCEA was invited to have its October 1990 meeting at UCSC. Some of the larger, older campus organizations have been active in representing the interests of emeriti in retirement issues (as the end of age-based retirement approaches) and in the utilization of interested emeriti in campus concerns, including instruction. The University Faculty Welfare Committee has maintained good liaison with CUCEA, so interests of emeriti have been served well.
